On Sunday, January 3, 2021, Mr. Barker (Archie) died at Mount Vernon Hospital after a short illness. He was born to James and Katherine Barker and grew up in Alexandria, Virginia. Archie is survived by his wife of over 48 years, Jacqueline (Jackie) Barker. Archie had five siblings, two brothers: (1) James Jr. and (2) Steven; and three sisters: (3) Brenda, (4) Linda, and (5) Debbie.
