Ronald E. Thibodeau, 78, of Dale City, Virginia, died at home on June 6, 2021, surrounded by his loving family.

Born in Detroit, Michigan in 1943 and raised in Mishawaka, Indiana, Ron enlisted in the United States Navy in 1961 with his brother Dave. He was known as a Mustang, meaning he started his military career as an enlisted serviceman, and retired as a commissioned officer. He retired from the Navy in 1988 after a distinguished 27-year career, at the rank of Lieutenant Commander.

After retiring from the military, Ron worked in corporate management for over 20 years before transitioning into retirement full-time, where he enjoyed spending time with family, woodworking, and adding tools to his already massive collection.

He is preceded in death by his parents, the late Edwin Thibodeau and the late Mary Thibodeau of Mishawaka, Indiana, and his brother Robert Thibodeau of Mishawaka, Indiana.
