Bernard "Buddy" A. Sekely Jr., of Woodbridge, Virginia, passed away on March 22, 2026.

Buddy dedicated his life to service. He spent 20 years as a police officer with the Fairfax County Police Department, followed by a second career as a Security Specialist for Fairfax County Public Schools. He concluded his service at McLean High School, retiring in August 2023. He was a member of Fairfax County Police Association, as well as held membership with the National Fraternal Order of Police. Throughout his life, Buddy was deeply committed to serving his community, as well as his family and friends. In his free time, he enjoyed golfing, riding his motorcycle, and especially cherished spending time with his grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Bernard "Bernie" A. Sekely Sr. and Theresa "Dolly" C. Sekely.

Buddy is lovingly remembered by his wife, Francie; his daughter, Carlie Wesche (Matt); his son, Drew Sekely (Kristina); his grandsons, Jake Montrose and Corbin Wesche; his granddaughters, Olivia Wesche, Paige Wesche, and Stella Sekely; and his sisters, Linda Keppler, Laura Gilmartin (Jeff), Laverne Zimmer (Buddy), and Lisa Witkowski.
