Bettye Jo (Denmon) Johnson, 85, of Dale City, Virginia, passed away peacefully on October 27, 2024, at Sentara Medical Center, surrounded by her family. She was a devoted homemaker/domestic engineer and childcare nurturer for many children in her community.

Bettye was a faithful member of the Jehovah's Witness Church and cherished her spiritual community. She enjoyed being in nature, an accomplished master gardener, and an environmentalist who could transform anything into beauty with ease and care.
