Brendan wanted to use his own struggles as a source of empathy, healing, and motivation for others, driven by a belief that no one should ever have to suffer alone.

He is survived by his loving parents, Joseph Michael Hart and Suzanne Michelle Doucet-Hart, his older brother Garrett Michael Hart, and his younger sister Ashley Katelynn Hart, who will always cherish his memory and the warmth he brought into their lives.

Brendan's light, though gone too soon, continues to shine through the love and kindness he showed others every day. His family and friends will remember him as a brilliant young man with a generous heart — a person who gave freely, thought deeply, and loved fiercely.
