Dr. Cerina Wanzer Fairfax, DDS, 49, of Fairfax Virginia, died April 16th, 2026 at her home.

She was raised in Woodbridge, Virginia. Cerina graduated with honors from Woodbridge High School in 1995. She continued her undergraduate education and received her Bachelor's Degree from Duke University in 1999. She then continued onto Virginia Commonwealth University where she pursued her passion to support others by obtaining her Doctor of Dental Surgery (DDS).

For nearly two decades, Cerina was a pillar of her community, building relationships both personally and professionally. She was a volunteer volleyball coach, an animal lover, an avid gardner and a huge fan of DIY projects. She founded Fairfax Dentistry and Associates, in Annandale, Virginia in 2007. There, her patients received not only the care they needed, but more so, the friendship they came to know and love.

While doing all of this, her heart belonged to her two children. They were the center of her life and the drive behind every decision she made. Her passion was to create a happy life for them and provide them with every opportunity to succeed.

She and her family are members of St. Ambrose Catholic Church.

Dr. Fairfax is survived by her children, Cameron and Carys, her mother Conchita Wanzer-Clark, her father Kevin Pope, her stepfather Sidney Clark, Jr., her brother Kevin Pope and her two sisters Arisce Wanzer and Dawn Cook.

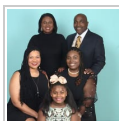
