Chao Ching Pa, a beloved father and husband, passed away on the evening of Sunday, June 29th, 2025 at the age of 92. He was born on June 24, 1933, in Henan, China.

Chao Ching's childhood was deeply impacted by the war with Japan and then the internal conflict between China's political parties. In 1949, he fled to Taiwan with his family, where he later joined the Navy after graduating from high school. During his military service, Chao Ching received numerous accolades and awards, ultimately retiring from the Navy at the age of 40.

Chao Ching married his loving wife, Yu Ying, in 1961 in Kaohsiung, Taiwan. In hopes of better prospects and education for their children, the family immigrated to the US in the mid 1970's and settled in Arlington, Virginia.

Chao Ching retired at the age of 67 from Win Labs in Fairfax, VA and moved to Tysons Tower Senior Living where he was well known for his involvement with the Chinese community.

He was a devoted husband, father and grandfather and enjoyed spending time with family and friends. He volunteered as the spokesperson for the Chinese community at Tysons Tower as well as many social events held there. He also enjoyed babysitting grandkids when they were young and often served as chauffeur for many grandkids activities.

Chao Ching is survived and missed by his wife, Yu Ying; two sons and one daughter-in-law, Yanhong, and Yanyie (May); one daughter and one son-in-law, Yierou Mahoney (Jonathan); four grandchildren, Schyler Pa, Brandon Pa,

Jordan Mahoney and Elijah Mahoney; and one sister, Li-Chuan Chu. He also leaves many friends who will sadly miss him.

He requested not to have a memorial service and wished that all family and friends cherish their fondest memories of him in their hearts. The interment will be held at Fairfax Memorial on Thursday, July 17th, 2025 for immediate family members.
