Charles Edward Wraase, “Charlie” died March 30, 2023 at Fairfax Inova Hospital in Fairfax, Virginia. He was born February 27, 1935 in Mount Clare, West Virginia. He grew up in the Washington, DC area, graduated from Bladensburg High School in 1953 and married Ann Beverly O’Neill on August 20, 1955. After high school Charles served in the United States Army. After leaving the Army, Charles started working for Pepco, retiring in 1990 after 33 years. Known for his sense of humor, his nickname at Pepco was Charlie Tuna.
