Col. David Hamilton Shelley, 68, of Woodbridge, VA, passed away on February 2, 2025 peacefully at home. He was born April 20, 1956 in Paris, France, and later raised in Vienna, Virginia where he attended James Madison High School. Col. Shelley attended the University of Tennessee-Knoxville, and was a member of Phi Sigma Kappa fraternity where he served as chapter president for two years in his tenure.

Upon graduation from the University of Tennessee, he received his Commission as a second Lieutenant in the United States Army. While active duty, Col. Shelley earned an MBA from the University of Maryland, a Masters in International Relations, and attended Harvard War College. Col. Shelley was a retired Special Operations and infantry officer and retired holding the rank of Colonel in the United States Army and retired after serving our country for 24 years. Upon retiring from the United States Army, he continued to serve our country working for the Department of Defense for 21 years. He was a true patriot and hero to this country. He was a voracious reader, with an excellent grasp of history and a strong sense of duty.

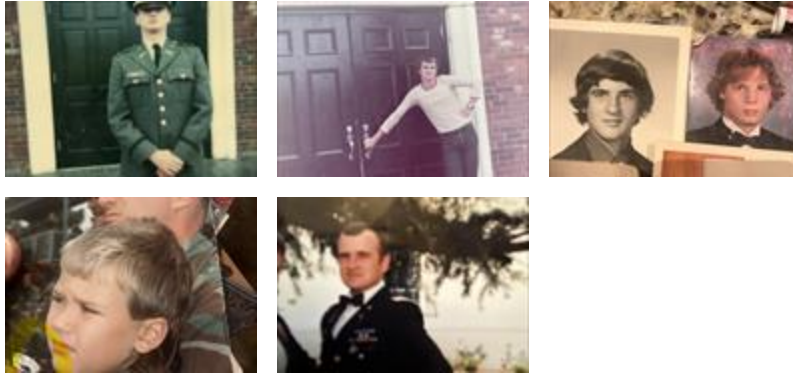
