Debora Jean Adamson Geddes passed away on March 4, 2024, in Woodbridge, Virginia. Deb, as everyone knew her, was born March 3, 1959, in Lubbock, Texas to D.R. and Joy Ann Adamson. Deb was married on June 7, 1984, to James R. Geddes II at the St. Paul's Episcopal Church in Lubbock, Texas.

Deb decided from an early age that she wanted a career in nursing. Beginning in 1976, she worked as a Respiratory Therapist until she began her nursing career in 1978 as a Registered Nurse (RN) at Methodist Hospital in Lubbock, Texas.

Her love of nursing was in the specialized Emergency/Trauma field, where she worked throughout her nursing career. In 1984, Deb received her degree in nursing, and in 1986, she was certified by the Texas Board of Emergency Nursing as a Certified Emergency Nurse (CEN). From 1984 through 1999, Deb worked as a RN/CEN in emergency rooms in Lubbock, Brownfield, and McAllen Texas. Deb's character was well suited to the high pressure and challenging environment of emergency nursing. In addition to working as an RN/CEN Deb also held a Peace Officers Certification from the State of Texas, issued in 1986, where she worked as a Reserve Deputy Sheriff for Terry County, Texas.

In 1999, Deb left her nursing career when the family moved from Texas to Woodbridge, Virginia, deciding to focus on raising her sons, Michael and Christopher. She loved cooking, crafting, and spending time with her family and friends. Deb's generosity and kindness was pervasive, and her patience unmatched. She was the pillar of her family and became a home away from home for many of her sons' friends.

As we honor Deb's life, we carry forward her spirit, positive outlook on life, unending kindness, and unwavering integrity. Her devotion to her family and friends will be cherished and remembered by all who knew her.

Deb was preceded in death by her parents D.R. and Joy Ann Adamson, along with several aunts and uncles.

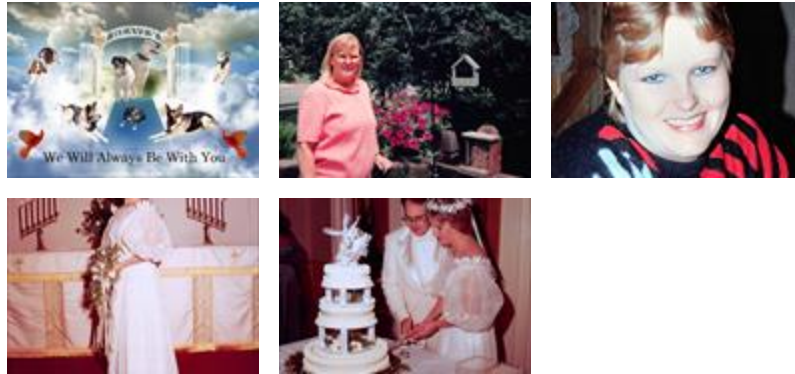
