A dear friend. A trusted colleague. A constant presence.

Some people walk into your life and quietly become part of the rhythm of it — so woven into your days that you stop noticing they're there, until they're not.

Derek was that person for me. For fourteen years, we shared the small, ordinary hours that most people never think about — the early mornings before the office came to life, the long afternoons, the end-of-day conversations that somehow always stretched longer than they were supposed to. He was the kind of colleague who made the work feel lighter, not because he made it easier, but because his company made everything feel more worthwhile. He had a way of showing up — not just physically, but fully. He listened when you talked. He remembered what mattered to you. He'd ask about your weekend on Monday, and he actually wanted to know the answer. In a world that moves fast and forgets quickly, Derek paid attention. That was one of his quiet gifts.

He didn't need a reason to check in, and he never made you feel like a burden. He was simply there — reliably, generously, warmly there.

Fourteen years is a long time to share a life with someone. Long enough to weather change together, to see each other through hard seasons and good ones, to become a part of each other's stories in ways neither of you planned. I am so grateful our stories crossed. I am richer for having known him.

The world is quieter without Derek in it. But his kindness — the easy laugh, the steady presence, the way he made ordinary days feel like something — that doesn't go away. It lives in the people he touched, in the small ways we carry him forward.

Rest easy, my friend.

You were one of the good ones and will be missed.
