February 13, 1928 - April 13, 2026

Dolores Wilson lived a long and meaningful life defined by strength, resilience, and unwavering devotion to her family. In her young adult years, she was a proud military wife, traveling extensively while raising her four children, who were born in different states across the United States and even in Morocco, Africa. Through constant change and movement, she remained the steady foundation of her family—the glue that held everyone together.

She went on to become a dedicated and accomplished professional, spending many years working in Jersey City, New Jersey, as a bookkeeper and accountant. She later retired from the Hudson County Clerk's Office in her 70s.

Throughout her career, she carried herself with strength, grace, and a deep sense of responsibility. A trailblazer in her field, she overcame racial barriers and helped open doors for future generations of Black professionals. In several roles, she was the first Black woman hired and faced immense pressure, as employers made it clear that her performance would influence opportunities for those who followed. She met that challenge with determination and excellence.

She was deeply loved by her family and respected by her peers, leaving behind a legacy of strength, unity, and a quiet yet powerful impact.
