Earlyne Whitten Lawrence, 78, of Lake Ridge, Virginia, formerly of Springfield, MO, passed away peacefully at her home on September 15, 2021 after being ill for some time.

Earlyne was born in Portland, Maine on January 15, 1943 to her late parents, Earl and Helen Whitten. In addition to her parents, she was preceded in death by her husband, Ernest William Lawrence and her sister, Florence Whitten Durham.
