Edward "Bret" Coulson, 64, of Dumfries, Virginia died November 30, 2023, at home.

A pillar of the Prince William County community, Bret served in a variety of leadership capacities, including as the President of the Historic Dumfries Virginia, Inc. / Weems-Botts Museum and as the Director and Vice-President of the Friends of Dumfries Slave Cemetery, Inc.

Bret spent over 25 years as a senior political advisor between the U.S. House of Representatives, the White House, the U.S. Arms Control and Disarmament Agency, and Amtrak. Following his work in the federal government, he worked as an independent consultant for more than ten years, sharing his wealth of knowledge and expertise on program management, public communications, and government relations.

An unparalleled historian, Bret's love and passion for reading, continuous learning, and educating inspired him to write 6 books on a variety of subjects such as the Vietnam War, Civil War, and local Northern Virginia history. His family intends on publishing each historical manuscript in his memory.

Bret was preceded in death by his father and mother, James and Dale [nee Pinchot] Coulson. He is survived by his wife, Joan [nee Bagley] Coulson;

daughter, son-in-law, and grandson, Lexie Coulson, Stephen Boensel, and James Boensel; daughter, Sybella Coulson; son, Derun Coulson; brother, Scot Coulson; and sisters, Darcy [nee Coulson] Reed and Jaime [nee Coulson] Heil.

A memorial service is scheduled for 11:00 a.m. on Friday, December 15, 2023 at the Miller Funeral Home, 3200 Golansky Boulevard, Woodbridge, Virginia 22192. The family will receive visitors from 10:00 a.m. to 11:00 a.m. at the funeral home and again at the Jeff Simpson Community Center located at 17757 Main Street Dumfries, VA 22026 from 12:30 p.m. to 2:30 p.m.
