With deep love and sadness, we announce the passing of Eugene Gerald Crawley, 82, of Woodbridge, VA. A devoted father, grandfather, and friend, Eugene died peacefully at Sentara Hospital.

Born in Williamsport, Pennsylvania, Eugene—known fondly as “Gene” to many—lived a life grounded in service, family, and quiet joy. Over the course of a distinguished 35-year career as a federal employee, Gene dedicated himself to the Department of the Treasury and the Department of Housing and Urban Development. He retired in 2005, leaving behind a legacy of professionalism, integrity, and dedication.

Gene's calling was found not only in his work, but in the lives he touched beyond the office. A lifelong supporter of the Boy Scouts of America, he gave countless hours leading and mentoring young scouts, including his sons, John and Jason. His summers were often spent outdoors—at campgrounds, on hikes, around campfires—instilling values and building memories that endure today.

One of Gene's greatest passions was model railroading. Alongside his brother

Gary and his children, he brought miniature worlds to life with patience, creativity, and care. Whether meticulously crafting landscapes or running his trains through the towns he built, Gene found joy in the hobby he loved so much.

Family meant everything to Gene. He was a proud and loving father to John Crawley (John) and Jason Crawley (Meredith), and a grandfather to Collin, Hannah, and Lauren Crawley. He is preceded in death by his parents, Jasper and Lenore Crawley, and his brother Gary.

He will be remembered for his steady presence, his sense of humor, and the simple, meaningful ways he showed up for the people in his life. He leaves behind not just cherished memories, but a legacy of strength, generosity, and enduring love.

A service to celebrate Eugene's life will be held at Miller Funeral Home in Woodbridge, Virginia on July 12th at 5:00 PM, with visitation beginning at 3:00 PM. Friends and loved ones are warmly invited to attend and share in remembering a life well-lived.
