Everett Staples, 92, of Lake Ridge, VA passed away at home on April 29, 2022.

Everett grew up in Brunswick, Maine where he was active in Scouting and the Civil Air Patrol. he got his drivers license at age 15, and his pilots license at age 16. Upon graduation from high school in 1948, he joined the U.S. Army and spent the next 20 years on various military assignments in the U.S.; Germany; Iran; Eritrea and Vietnam.

Over the years, Everett was able to acquire an Associate in Arts degree in Business Data Processing; a Bachelor of Arts degree in Political Science; and a Master of Science in Administration degree in Information Systems Technology.
