Lieutenant Colonel George R. Frank, USMC (Ret.)

Born in Washington, D.C. in 1935, he graduated from Gonzaga High School in 1952. He won a Congressional appointment to the Naval Academy, spent four years with the 7th Company and graduated in 1957. Upon graduation, he followed his father's 37 years of service and joined the Marine Corps as an infantry officer. During a tour at Camp Lejeune, NC in 1963, he met Virginia Rakow and they were married in February 1964. His 23 years of active duty included tours in Vietnam in 1966 and 1970/71, several tours in Washington, including a year as the Marine Corps Aide to the Assistant Secretary of the Navy, and a year at the Army War College. His military awards include the Legion of Merit, the Bronze Star with Combat V, the Navy Commendation Medal with Combat V, the Combat Action Ribbon and several unit commendations and Republic of Vietnam awards.

George earned a Master of Science degree from the Naval Postgraduate School in 1967. He retired from the Marine Corps in 1980, while living in the Washington suburb of Woodbridge, VA, and worked with defense contracting in the field of electromagnetic technology. After several moves in the Woodbridge area, he and Ginny finally settled in a house they loved on the Occoquan River in Lake Ridge. He worked into his seventies and enjoyed jogging, reading, bridge and, most of all, being with his beloved wife of 60

years, his sons Tom and Mike and his four grandchildren, David, Adam, William and Eddie.

George died peacefully as a result of Parkinson's on Tuesday, September 19. Visitation will be held Friday, September 22, from 5:00-8:00 pm at Miller Funeral Home in Woodbridge, VA. A funeral mass and full military services will be held sometime in early 2024 at Arlington National Cemetery.
