George Edward Simpson Jr., age 66, passed of natural causes on October 6, 2020, at his residence in Woodbridge, VA.

George is survived by his mother Mary Simpson; his wife Cindy Freeland-Simpson; his two sons Jason Simpson and Justin Simpson; his two daughters Misty Simpson, Lindsay Erbe, and one step daughter Bridgett Freeland; his five grandchildren, Tyler Simpson, Devin Simpson, Brennan Simpson, Kayden Jackson, Aliyah Jackson, and four step grandchildren Logan Whitaker, Leonard Gaskins, Lennox Gaskins, Lathius Gaskins. George was the oldest of nine, and a single Dad to his children. He was a very sweet and loving husband to his wife of 14 years. He enjoyed life, was full of fun and a child at heart - they all loved "uncle glute".
