



## George Franklin Wright

August 1, 1943 - October 2, 2023

George Franklin Wright, 80, of Woodbridge Virginia, died October 2nd at the Adler Center in Loudoun County after a 5-year battle with lung cancer. He was born in Philadelphia in 1943. After completing high school, he joined the Navy and served on the USS Cromwell. After being honorably discharged, he attended college at the University of Southern Mississippi and went on to study law at Samford University in Birmingham where he met his wife, Polly. He also went on to earn a Master's degree in Tax from George Washington University. He was a tax attorney for the IRS at the national office until he retired in 2009. He was a dedicated member of Immanuel Anglican Church serving on the Vestry and Stephen's Ministries.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Robert and Sarah Wright, and his wife of 35 years, Polly.

He is survived by his three daughters, Lisa Wright of Sherman Oaks, California, Margaret (Marli) Wright of Woodbridge, and Sarah Wright of Lynchburg, Virginia. He is also survived by his older brother Robert Wright of Atlanta Georgia and many beloved nieces and nephews.

A memorial service is scheduled for Thursday, October 12th at 10 a.m. at All Saints Church in Woodbridge. Interment will follow at the National Memorial Cemetery at Quantico at 1:30 p.m.
