Mr. Gilmore Lescalleet, Jr., 102, last residing in Woodbridge, VA, died at Belvoir Health Care Center on October 4, 2022. He was the husband of Barbara N. Lescalleet who still lives in Woodbridge, VA.

Born on December 26, 1919 in Frederick, MD, he was the son of the late Gilmore and Regina (Haller) Lescalleet.

Mr. Lescalleet was a veteran of the United States Army Air Force, having served during World War II. He was a Staff Sergeant and served for 3 1/2 years, both in the United States and overseas in the Pacific Theater of Operations. He was stationed on the island of Okinawa when the atom bombs were dropped on Hiroshima and Nagasaki, Japan in 1945.

After the war, he began a 31 year career with the Peoples Life Insurance Company in Washington, D.C. where he served as a department manager until his retirement in 1977.

He was a long-time member of Calvary United Methodist Church in Frederick. He and Barbara started to attend Hughes United Methodist Church in Wheaton, MD during the 1950's and currently remain as listed members of the Church.

He is survived by his wife, Barbara Nicodemus Lescalleet, his daughter, Ann F. Lescalleet in Woodbridge, VA, and son, David G. Lescalleet and wife, Cindy Lescalleet in Troutdale, OR, and son, Brian R. Lescalleet in Silver Spring, MD, two grandchildren, Kristin Williams and Daniel Lescalleet, and great grandchild, Luka Velazco.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sister, Roberta H. Wertz and husband, Stanley H. Wertz.

As arranged by Miller Funeral Home of Woodbridge, VA, the interment funeral service will begin at 12pm on Monday, October 10, 2022 at the Lescalleet family lot in Mt. Olivet Cemetery in Frederick, MD.
