Gregory Le Roy Twombley, 64, of Woodbridge, VA, died December 25, 2022 at Sentara Northern Virginia Medical Center.

Upon graduation from South Dakota State University, Greg taught high school band in Iowa. In 1986, Greg auditioned for and was selected to join the U.S. Army Band “Pershing’s Own”. Greg retired after a 20-year career as a Master Sergeant from the U.S. Army Band “Pershing’s Own” on January 1, 2007. At the time of his death, Greg was serving as the Director of Ministries and Praise Team Leader at the Lutheran Church of Saint Andrew, in Silver Spring, MD.

He was preceded in death by his parents, the late Le Roy Twombley and the late Maralyn Twombley, and his son, Todd Twombley. Greg is survived by his wife, Jennifer; children, Lauran, Tyler, and Lindsey; grandsons, Benjamin, Connor, and Sebastian; brothers, Wayne and James.

A service is being planned and will be held at a future date at the Lutheran Church of Saint Andrew, with interment to be held at Arlington National Cemetery.

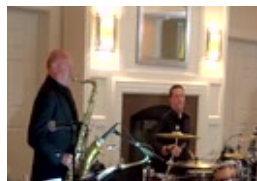
