Ignaz Roy Jarbadan, (“Roy”), 54, of Fairfax Station, VA, was born in Man, WV on September 24, 1971. He passed away peacefully on June 8, 2026, at home, surrounded by his loving parents and siblings, after a long battle with cancer.

Roy graduated from James Madison University in 1993. He briefly worked as a substitute teacher for Fairfax County Public Schools. He then completed additional courses at George Mason University as a pre-requisite for medical school, while devoting his time to serving others through volunteer work. He served as a chaperone for the youth group at Lake Ridge Baptist Church, delivered for Meals on Wheels, and rode with a local ambulance service. Roy went on to attend medical school at American University of the Caribbean School of Medicine, graduating in 2002. After clinical rotations in England and Detroit, MI, he pursued and completed Residency in Internal Medicine at Wright State University in 2008, and he became board-certified. Roy was employed as a hospitalist at Sentara RMH Medical Center (formerly Rockingham Memorial Hospital) in Harrisonburg, VA.

Roy was a Christian, having accepted Jesus Christ as his Lord and Savior. He

was a loving son, brother, and uncle-“maninoy.” Roy was fiercely protective of his family, loyal to his friends, and he loved with all his heart. He absolutely treasured the time he spent with his family. He also had a passion for great food and travel. Roy was caring and kind, and his generosity knew no bounds. He was incredibly loved and will be deeply missed.

Roy is survived by his parents, Ignaz P. Jarbadan and Nancy C. G.
