Jeffrey W. Trullender, 54, of Lake Ridge, Virginia, died on September 20, 2025, at Sentara Hospital following a courageous battle from Hepatocellular Carcinoma (HCC).

Jeff was preceded in death by his father, J. Warren Trullender and mother, Linda J. Trullender of Alexandria.

Jeff is survived by his wife of 28 years Elizabeth (Ann) Booth Trullender, his son, Cole G. Trullender (Alison) of Lorton, and his daughter, Kara G. Trullender, who is attending the University of Pittsburgh. He recently became a proud Pops to granddaughter, Lucy Trullender. Jeff is also survived by two brothers, Jonathan (Jon) W. Trullender (Mallory) and James W. Trullender (Olena), several nieces, nephews, and extended family, all of whom loved him dearly.

Jeff served as a Master Deputy Sheriff and dedicated twenty-nine years of distinguished service to the Fairfax County Sheriff's Office. He considered the agency his second family and formed lifelong friendships along the way. Jeff loved his country and served as a first responder during the aftermath of the 9/11 attack at the Pentagon.

Jeff is remembered for his love of family and friends, and for enjoying life

outdoors. He loved to spend time in the mountains fishing, camping, riding his ATV, and hiking at the Hoye family farm in Sang Run, Maryland; and more recently, fishing and being at the helm of his boat in Reedville, Virginia. His family and friends often gathered at the river to enjoy holidays, eat crabs and oysters, and to enjoy the water. Jeff was especially happy when he spent time watching Cole and Kara play lacrosse during their time on travel teams, high school, and ultimately at their universities. He truly loved them and was immensely proud of their accomplishments.

He will be missed by all who had the honor of calling him a family member and a friend.
