Kelvin loved his family; cooking; gardening; all types of music; his loud truck; fireworks and being of service to his spiritual family at the Neabsco Baptist Church in Woodbridge, VA.

Kelvin was born in Clarksville, VA on June 16, 1957, to the late Bernice Fuller-Cook and Fred Lee Scott. He was reared under the loving care and guiding hand of his grandparents, the late Jesse and Inez Fuller. They taught him to love God, the importance of family and the meaning of honest work.
