



## Mae Yi Shore

March 3, 1944 - February 21, 2019

Mae Yi Shore, beloved mother and wife, passed away peacefully on February 21, 2019 at Sentara Northern Virginia Medical Center in Woodbridge, VA. She was 74.

Mae was born on March 3, 1944 in Yeosu, Korea. While in Korea, she met her husband, Randall Shore, while he was stationed there for the Air Force. Despite the language barrier, Mae and Randall fell in love.

Having never been outside of Korea she traveled to the United States to be with Randall in 1971, where they were married in Lawrence, Kansas. In 1972, they welcomed their first child, Aron. Soon after in 1974, they welcomed their second child, Donna.

That same year, Mae became a naturalized citizen of the United States after long hours of studying English and US history. She did this all while juggling two kids; many times even by herself.

Her hard work and generosity never went unnoticed. An Air Force wife for 24 years, she spent 13 of them overseas in the Pacific, enduring eight moves in between.

Mae was known for her zest for life, love of family, friends and cooking for all.

She is survived by her husband (Randall Shore) of 47 years, two children (Aron and Donna), three grandchildren (Jasmine, Nataly and Kayden) and two great grandchildren (Steven & Sofia).
