Margaret A. "Peg" Jennings, 76, of Woodbridge, VA died July 28th, at home from lewy body dementia. Peg was born Margaret Ann Stickney in Rochester, New York, on January 8, 1944. She was the daughter of Floyd and Marion Stickney. The family moved to Virginia when she was six years old. Peg attended elementary school in Norfolk and middle school in Falls Church at St. James. In 1961 she graduated from Denis J. O'Connell High School in Arlington.

After graduation Peg spent nine years working for the Internal Revenue Service as a program analyst. In 1968 she married Robert "Bob" Jennings and subsequently resigned from the IRS after her daughter Sheila was born in 1970. In 1973 the family moved to the Dale City section of Woodbridge where the family currently lives. After Sheila attended public school, Peg began taking courses at Northern Virginia Community College in mathematics.

In 1984 Peg decided to return to the work force. She accepted a position at Kerrydale Elementary School as a library secretary. She remained in the Prince William County school system until her retirement in 2005.

Peg enjoyed playing black jack at Atlantic City. She spent her vacations at Conesus Lake in upstate New York and Cape Cod. Sports were also her interest. At one time Peg had season tickets to the old Washington Senators

and Capitals hockey.

Peg is survived by her husband Bob of Woodbridge; daughter Sheila Ganino and her husband Tony of Azusa, CA; granddaughters Alyssa Ganino of Blacksburg, VA; and Haley Ganino of Azusa, CA; brother Chuck Stickney and his wife Joanne of Jacksonville, FL; sister Mary Kay Mullane and her husband James of Shickshinny, PA; brother Tom Stickney and his wife Mary of Vienna, VA; brother Jack Stickney and wife Teresa of Irvine, KY. She also enjoyed the company of her many nieces and nephews.
