Martin Barrett Newdorf, 78, of Woodbridge, Virginia, died October 21, 2025. A native New Yorker, Martin studied Engineering at Brooklyn's Polytechnic University. He served in the United States Army during the Vietnam War. During his time in the military he earned the rank of Lieutenant Colonel. In the 1970s Martin moved to the DC metro area and was employed by the US Government as a civil engineer. After retiring from the Department of Energy in 2008, he volunteered for the Prince William County Library System, worked local elections, and took his Golden Retriever, Henry, outside multiple times a day.

Martin loved animals, science fiction, and trains. He was a member of many model train clubs and had his own multitrack layout.

He was preceded in death by his parents, Laura and Louis Newdorf.

Martin is survived by his wife, Ellen; children, Larry (Janice), Sarah (Paul), and Rachel; grandchildren, Justin and Jessica. They miss him very much.

Graveside services will be held at Quantico National Cemetery on Friday, November 7 at 10:30am.
