Hartman, Norbert M. (93) Retired Army SGM, passed away Wednesday, February 11, 2026 in Woodbridge, VA.

Born in Manitowoc, WI he was drafted into the Army, having spent a career in the Army of 26 years. He retired in 1980. He primarily served in Engineer Combat Battalions. He was employed by Army civil service for 14 more years at Fort Belvoir. He married his soulmate, Gilberte Legesne in 1958 while on his first deployment to France.

While hop scotching the world they had four daughters. All surviving: Anita and Frank Comperda of Harvest, AL; Cindy at home Woodbridge, VA; Linda and Jim Collins of Mesquite, TX; Lisa and Jerry Czarnecki of Perkasio, PA.
