



## Patrick Henry Padberg

Patrick “Pat” Henry Padberg, 81, of Alexandria, VA passed away at home on July 25, 2025. Pat was born in Washington D.C. to Edwin and Hildegarde Padberg and was raised in Arlington and Alexandria.

Pat graduated from Mt. Vernon High School in 1962 and began work at Mt. Vernon Research. In June of 1963, Pat attended Alexandria Institute of Technology and earned an associate degree from Richmond Professional Institute in 1966. He then went on to work at the Newport News Shipbuilding and Dry Dock Company as a junior designer.

Pat met his wife Jo Anne (Smith) in 1963 and they were married in June 1967. Pat joined the U.S. Navy as a Seabee and was deployed to Vietnam where he was stationed in Da Nang and Hoi An from December 1967 to August of 1968. His second deployment was to Palmer Station, Antarctica from December of 1968 to April 1969. Pat was honorably discharged in June of 1969.

Pat and Forest (Willie) Mayes owned and operated a successful construction company (PMC Contractors) for 32 years in Northern Virginia.

Pat is survived by his wife Jo Anne of Alexandria, VA, sons Christopher Alan (Khristina Beth) of Dumfries, VA, Paul Edwin (Jennifer Judith) of Woodbridge,

VA, grandchildren Mary Beth, Richard Alan (Taylor), Jack Thomas, SPC, US Army, and Paige Jennifer (Grady Dillon). Pat will be dearly missed by all of us who had the privilege to know him.

The family will receive friends on Sunday, August 17, 2025 from 6-8:00 p.m. at Miller Funeral Home, 3200 Golansky Blvd., Woodbridge, VA 22192. Interment with military honors will take place at Quantico National Cemetery at a later date.
