Paul Lars Bredholt, beloved husband, son, father, and grandfather, passed away unexpectedly in his sleep at the age of 57 on June 17th, 2023. He is survived by his wife, LeAnne Bredholt; his mother, Lillian Bredholt; his daughters, Megan Bredholt, Katie (Sean) Richards, and April Bredholt; his grandchildren, Wyatt Campbell, Samuel Richards, and Clementine Richards; and his sister, Jeanne (Dave) Jachim. Paul was preceded in death by his father, Rev. Roy A. Bredholt; his brother, Roy A. Bredholt Jr.; and his sisters, Elizabeth Bredholt and Christine Bredholt.

Born on October 28th, 1965 in Portland, ME, Paul was the youngest of Roy and Lillian's children. Their family moved to various locations and eventually settled in Fargo, ND. Paul met his wife LeAnne in 1986 while working at Park River Bible Camp and the two were married on July 25th, 1987. Paul entered the U.S. Air Force in 1989 and received his commission through the Officers Training School at Lackland AFB, TX. He began his career as a missileer in Grand Forks and retired after 20 years of service as a Lt. Colonel and Commander of the 37th Logistics Readiness Squadron in Lackland AFB, TX. During his military service, he deeply cared for the well-being of his subordinates, mentoring and guiding them to reach their full potential. He exemplified the core values of integrity, courage, and commitment by serving his country with a brave and selfless dedication to others. He was awarded the Bronze Star Medal. After his military retirement, Paul worked as a

contractor for Booz Allen Hamilton and then as a federal government employee for the US Department of the Treasury. A man of great faith, Paul shared Christ with others through his humble spirit and caring acts of service. An avid lexophile, Paul was a formidable Scrabble opponent. All who knew him appreciated his sense of humor, quick wit, and loving spirit. He will be greatly missed by his family and friends.

A visitation and viewing will be held on June 30th, 2023 at Crossroads Presbyterian Church, 15557 Cardinal Drive, Woodbridge, VA 22192, at 10am with a service to follow directly at 11am. Interment at Quantico National Cemetery will follow at 1:30pm.
