The Rev. Paul Kabo, Jr., 76, of Bristow, VA, joined the glad heavenly reunion on May 30, 2021. He passed at home in his sleep after suffering from pancreatic cancer.

Paul was a Presbyterian minister until his retirement in 2010, serving churches in Ponca City, OK; Chester, IL; Louisville, KY; Cape Girardeau, MO; and Sainte Genevieve, MO. He attended Brentsville Presbyterian Church. He was a member of the Piedmont Railroaders, and served as the president of their board.

Paul was preceded in death by his parents, the late Paul Kabo and the late June Maczin, and his sister, Evelyn Dobroski. He is survived by his wife, Alice; sisters June Peterson and Loretta Peeples; son Erik and daughter-in-law Teresa; and grandsons Gabriel and Michael.

A memorial is scheduled for 5:30 PM Friday, June 11, at Miller Funeral Home, 3200 Golansky Blvd, Woodbridge. The family will receive visitors from 4:30 PM at the funeral home. The funeral home respectfully requests that you wear a mask, no matter your vaccination status.

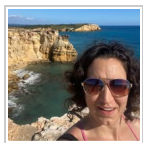
