Piroska Jozsa Daranyi
(September 7, 1936 – February 15, 2021)

Piroska Jozsa Daranyi, recognized as the “anchor” of her family and known to her friends as “Pat,” was born on September 7th, 1936 in Nádudvar, a town in Hajdú-Bihar County in the Northern Great Plain region of eastern Hungary. She left Hungary on November 22, 1956. She came to the United States on December 26, 1956 as a refugee from the Hungarian Revolution. On her way to the USA, she met her then-future husband Ferencz Jozsa and was married on December 15, 1957.

She lived most of her life in Virginia, but also lived in Washington, D.C. and Florida for a number of years. In 1957, she worked at the Colonial Inn. Later, she worked at the Marriot’s Hot Shoppe for 15 years. Finally, she finished her career working at Safeway (Union 400) in the meat department for 22 years. She retired in 1983.

Pat’s family, especially her children and her grand-children, have been her primary focus in life. She loved cooking and baking, and passed down that love to her family. To this day her family, those in the United States and in Hungary, remain close.

Her memories include many, many family gatherings, the “Hungarian Ball”, the numerous life lessons she passed on to her children, as well as, her Hungarian heritage. Her life experience in Hungary kept her very active in the Hungarian community.

Pat had always felt a connection to God. From childhood onward, she has loved God and believed that he was continually guiding her steps. He got her through the tough times: getting out of Hungary, coming to a new country, learning a new language and raising her family. As a Christian woman, she endeavored to raise her children in a way that they too would appreciate God. She taught her children to pray: the Lord’s pray, their bedtime prayers and always thanking God for the food they enjoyed. They prayed as a family in both the English and Hungarian languages.

Later in life, she began to study the Bible with Jehovah’s Witnesses and began to appreciate the truths that she was learning, including the resurrection hope of life on a Paradise Earth.

She will be missed by her daughter, Eva Jozsa of Woodbridge, VA and her three sons, Frank Jozsa (Patricia) of Woodbridge, Leslie Jozsa of Woodbridge and Steven J. Jozsa of Manassas VA, as well as former daughter-in-law, Kristy Miller. She is also survived by her brother Istvan Daranyi (Erszebet) her nieces and nephews and all her grandchildren and other beloved relatives.

She is preceded in death by her brother, György Daranyi and her sister, Rosa Daranyi Pap, who passed away in March 2016.

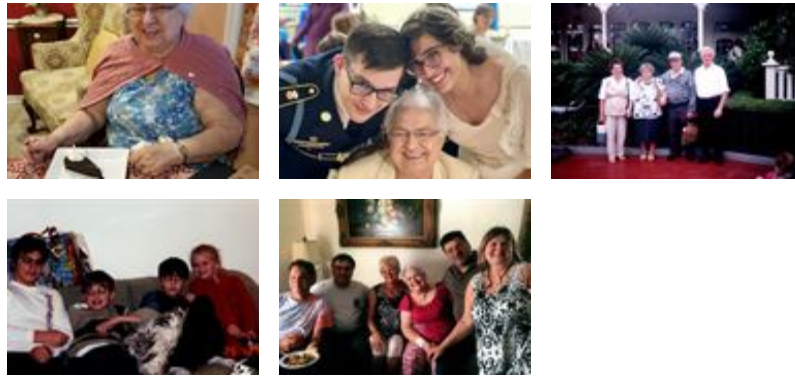
