Robert John “Bob” Piccoli of Montclair, VA passed away on Saturday March 28, 2020.

He was born to the late John and Rose Piccoli on October 19, 1942 in Brooklyn, NY. Bob graduated from St. John’s Preparatory School in NYC, NY and earned a degree in Pre-Med from Niagara University. He was married to Cathryn “Cathy” Piccoli on August 5, 1967.

Bob retired from The United States Army Active Reserve, Medical Service Corp after many years of faithful service. He was the manager of the National Rifle Association (NRA) Pistol Competitions division for over 20 years and served as the Statistical Director for the NRA National Matches, “The World Series of Shooting Sports,” which was held annually at Camp Perry, Ohio. He was also an active member in the Knight of Columbus at the Father Kelly Council in Woodbridge, VA and had held the titles of Grand Knight and Faithful Navigator.

Bob was an avid history buff, a long suffering Redskins fan, and enjoyed watching tennis and boxing. He remained a lifelong, broken-hearted Brooklyn Dodgers fan after the team moved to California in 1957. Bob loved to travel, especially by cruise, and got to see so many countries in his life, including some of his favorite cruises to Russia and Alaska. He was a collector of

watches, which he tried to coordinate by outfit in order to bring a smile to his wife's face, and maintained an unwavering faith in the superiority of all things Italian.

Bob was survived by his loving wife of 52 years, Cathy Piccoli; daughter MaryAnne Troyer (James); Sons Robert Piccoli (Paula) and Patrick Piccoli; grandchildren Kristin Mays (Andrew), Lauren Toots (Michael) and Mathew Piccoli; great grandchildren Caleb Mays and Mason Toots; Brother John Piccoli (Kathleen).

A mass will be held Friday April 3, 2020 at St. Francis of Assisi Parish with a burial to follow at Quantico National Cemetery. Due to the current circumstances, only his immediate family will be in attendance.
