The family of Roseann Cass is saddened to announce her passing at the age of 92. She was a beacon of strength and wisdom and loved by so many over her lifetime. She was preceded in death by her husband of 47 years, Don A. Cass. She was also preceded in death by her parents, Michael Haley and Margaret Noon, both of Philadelphia; one brother, Joseph Haley of Philadelphia and two sisters, Marie Roatcap and Peggy Haffelfinger. She is survived by all four of her children, Donald Cass (Linda) of Manassas, VA, James Cass of Edinburg, VA, Marie Cass Traylor (William) of Woodbridge, VA and Diane Cass (DuWayne) of Woodbridge, VA; as well as seven grandchildren and four great grandchildren.

She left her hometown of Philadelphia, PA in her early 20's to visit her sister living in Paris, France at the time. After several years living in the U.S., they relocated to Japan along with their three children, where they lived for five years. She often spoke very fondly of her time there, saying they were the "best years of her life".

Upon returning back to the United States, the family settled in Woodbridge, VA where they completed their family with their fourth child, Diane. Roseann

never met a stranger and everyone she met simply loved her. She developed many wonderful and lasting relationships with people of all ages.

They provided the utmost care, empathy, compassion, patience, flexibility and above all, LOVE. 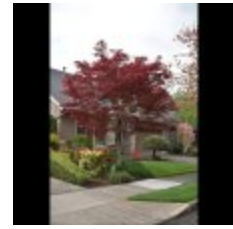
