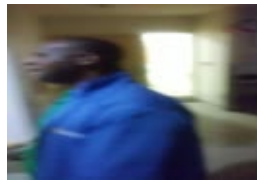
*Ruben will be laid to rest at Miller Funeral Home, Woodbridge, Virginia details of the arrangements will be determined on Monday,*

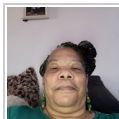
