On August 2, 2023, Russell Everett Thompson, 97, of Woodbridge Virginia passed away peacefully at home.

Born July 19, 1926, in Konnarock, Va., he was the son of the late Isaac “Ike” and Winnie Haga Thompson.

Russell was a Veteran of the US Army and served in the Pacific theater as a medic. He worked for the coal mines before moving to Woodbridge, Virginia in 1958. Russell worked for Allied Aviation as an airplane fueler at Reagan National Airport until his retirement in 1991.

Russell was an active member of the Occoquan Masonic Lodge #310 for 60 years. He was also a member of Prince of Peace United Methodist Church.

He is survived by his loving wife, Loraine. They were married for 74 years and had four sons, Jerry Thompson (Carol), Ronnie Thompson (Karen), Donald Thompson (Kelly), and Kenny Thompson (Judy). Also surviving is one brother, Charles (Bud) Thompson (Joann) of Mullens, West Virginia, 11 grandchildren and 19 great-grandchildren.

Russell loved his family dearly and was especially loved by all children, because of his playful nature. Playing the guitar was one of his talents of which he was self-taught.
