She was very proud of her work history and the roles and titles she held. Sherri was an active member and officer of the Benevolent and Protective Order of Elks in Woodbridge, VA for several years where she spent countless hours volunteering at events. She loved being with her friends, shopping, decorating, traveling, and being at the beach. Sherri passed away October 12, 2021 at Potomac Sentara Hospital in Woodbridge, VA. She will be remembered by many close friends.

Sherri had the kindest and most giving heart and with her passing, she was still able to give back by being an organ donor. The social butterfly she was, she wanted nothing more than love, joy, and happiness among anyone she met. She was very proud of her daughters' accomplishments.

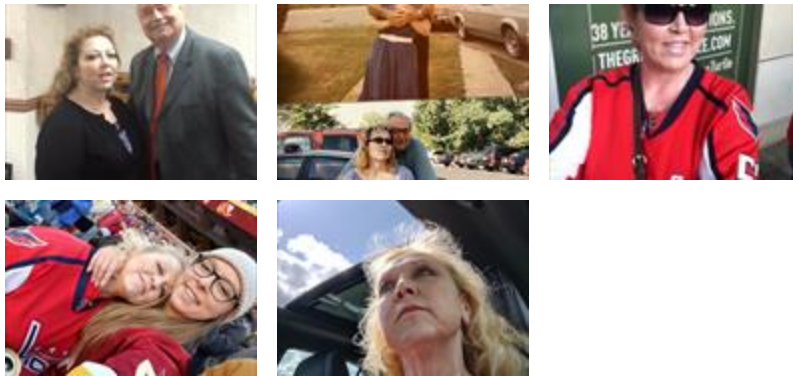

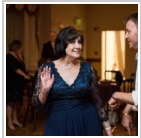
