Song Ok Witt was called home to Jesus on Monday, August 31, 2020 at age 78. Song was raised Presbyterian and attended Belvoir Chapel, Fort Belvoir, VA for 19 years.

Song was born in Chin Nam Po, Korea on December 14, 1941. Song met her husband, Cleveland Lewis Witt in 1963 and they married one year later. Song and Lewis had no children. Song is survived by a brother, Pak Ki Tok of Franconia, VA and two sisters Lee I Ok of Daejeon, South Korea and Yong Ok Yoon of Springfield, VA.

Song and Lewis were married 56 years. As a military spouse, Song accompanied her husband on assignments to Japan, Hawaii, New Zealand and Virginia, where she resided while Lewis served two tours in Vietnam.

Song worked throughout her life and most recently worked as Morning Supervisor at Morning Star Child Development Center in Woodbridge, VA. Song had a bountiful interest and love for children.

Song was both a Korean and American history buff and an avid reader. Abraham Lincoln and Korean King Sejong the Great were her favorite personalities to study. Song always had a book handy. She traveled extensively and visited 23 countries; most notably, Egypt, China and Russia,

to learn about their history and culture.
