Spyridon Gasialis, 89 of Fall River, MA passed away on Thursday, April 16, 2020 in Alexandria, VA after a brief illness.

Spyridon was born on April 12, 1931 in Agios Nicholaos, Thesprotia, Epirus Greece to Christos and Antonia Gasialis. He was predeceased by seven siblings.

He was married to Angeliki (Gatzoyiannis) for 68 years. He came to the United States with his family in 1968 in pursuit of the classic American dream.
