Stephen (Steve) Patrick Spellman, 62 years old, Husband of Stella Spellman, passed away early Monday January 29, 2024. Born December 15th, 1961 in Madison, Wisconsin to Patrick and Susan Spellman.

Stephen attended Middleton High School. He went on to study at the University of Wisconsin in Madison, and graduated from the University of Alaska, Fairbanks.

Stephen also received a second Master's Degree, in Sustainability Studies, from New England College. Steve held various leadership positions in the US Army, including Director of Occupational and Environmental Health. He retired from the military in 2016 as a Lieutenant Colonel. Upon retiring from Active Duty, he became the President of Angayut, LLC.

Stephen is survived by his son Stephen JR, his wife Stella, daughters Stephanie and Paisley as well as Stepdaughter Kylie. He is also survived by his mother, Sue and father, Pat Spellman, as well as his siblings Lisa and Tim.
