Suzi Hicks, 63, of Lorton, Virginia, departed June 3, 2021 at INOVA Fairfax Hospital, after a very difficult struggle with cancer.

Suzi was born in Heidelberg, Germany in 1957 to Saburo Robert Imai and Ingeborg Imai. Suzi relocated to the United States with her family in 1972. Suzi is preceded in death by her beloved husband, John Hicks and both of her parents.

Suzi enjoyed spending her teen years working on automobiles with her father and carried her love of automobiles and motorcycles into her adult years. 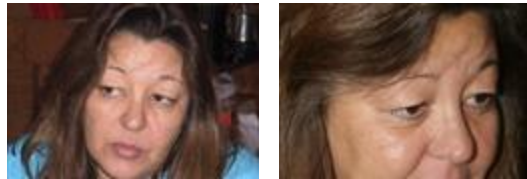
