She grew up in a large, loving family as the second of seven children. She learned to both play and work hard with three brothers and three sisters. She began developing her talents from her very loved and skilled mother and father. She learned to play the piano and clarinet. She was in the thespian club and served on the yearbook committee in high school; and attended Southern Utah State College.

Lloyd Earl DeLapp entered her life in early 1971 and they were married by May. Together they raised their treasured family of five. Three sons, Michael, Lee, and Randall followed by two beautiful daughters, Jeannine and Shirlene who completed their family. Virginia was a wonderful mom who loved her children fiercely. With devotion to motherhood, she taught them to love, be compassionate and fully enjoy life.

As her children grew, she continued her zest for life and the creative. She became quite talented in textile arts, such as crocheting, knitting, lacing, cross stitching, quilting, and sewing. She was known for her cake decorating, including wedding cakes, birthday cakes and made other desserts for family
