Wilbert A. Davis, Jr died May 31, 2021. He was born May 14, 1931 at Rockingham Memorial Hospital, Harrisonburg, VA.

He graduated from North River High School in 1948. He worked for Whetzel Feed Seed Store for two years and joined the Navy in 1950-1954 serving as 1st Class Petty Officer. Getting out of the Navy he went to work for Becker Electric in Alexandria from 1954-1961. He moved to Woodbridge, VA in 1958 and then went to work for the Department of Transportation (FAA) at Reagan National Airport. Davis retired in 1987. Before retiring he worked on Honda motorcycles turning it into a business later on as D&D Cycle of Woodbridge, VA. He was a life time member of Gold Wing Road Riders Association for over 20 years, Honda Riders Chapter of America and America Motorcycle Association.
