William D. Aubuchon of Woodbridge, VA died peacefully in his sleep at the home of his daughter and son-in law on Friday March 31, 2023, surrounded by family.

Bill was born in St. Louis, MO on June 17, 1928. He served in the United States Army for 33 years and retired as a CW4. His career in the Defense Intelligence Agency, Attaché Corps spanned the entire globe. He visited over 120 countries on 6 of the 7 continents. He served 15 years in Foreign Service, stationed in Germany, Turkey, Hungary, Belgium, Cyprus and Greece. His last assignment brought him back to the Pentagon. Upon his retirement he began teaching at the Defense Intelligence College at Bolling AFB. He retired fully after 8 years. He was the recipient of two Legion of Merit Medals along with numerous other awards.

Bill was preceded in death by his wife of 62 years, Vivian M Aubuchon.

Surviving are his daughter Alison Gingerich and her husband Tom, Nicole Hund and her husband Thor, his grandchildren Joshua Turk, Rachel Turk, Allanah Hund, Cody Hund and his great grandson Liam Turk.
